What are the advantages of co-teaching in Edmodo?

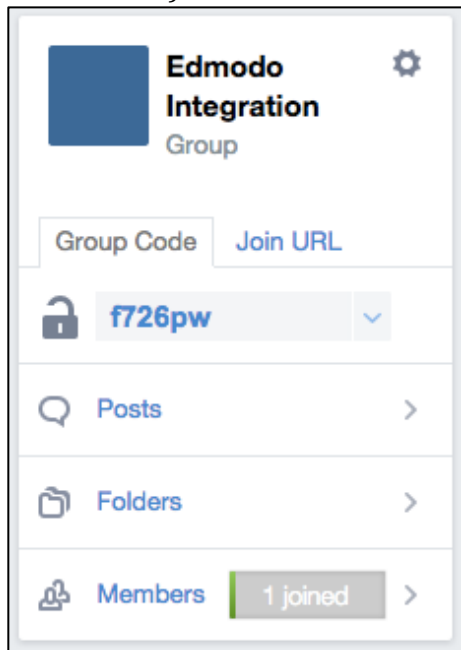
- ✓ Allows for the healthy exchange of ideas

- ✓ Grade

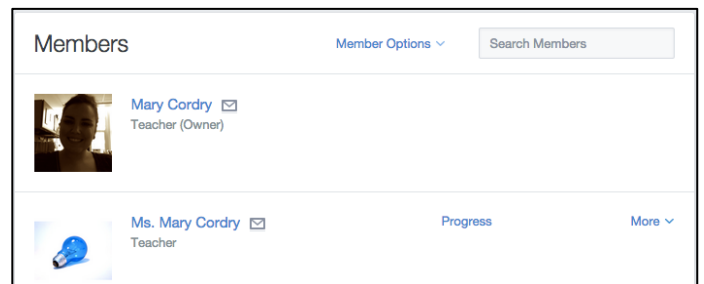
Setting Up a Co-Teacher in Edmodo:

1. Provide the teacher with the group code to join your course. The co-teacher will join the group just as student would (See Edmodo Basics for instructions).



2. Once the co-teacher has joined the group, the group creator will log in to the Edmodo group and select 'Members' from the left-hand menu.

3. In the Member's section, you will see all of the names of everyone enrolled in the group. Locate the co-teacher's name.



4. On the far right side, there is a dropdown button, 'More'. Select 'More' and change the access to 'Co-Teacher'.
