

# Edmodo Training – Advanced Tips & Tricks

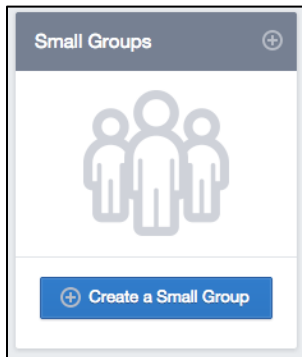
## Small Groups:

Ideas for using Small Groups in Edmodo:

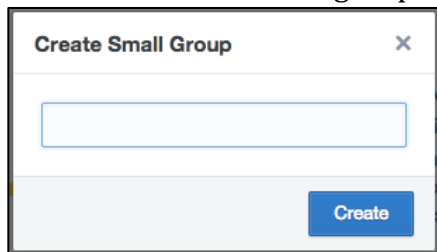
- ✓ For projects or team-based activities such as literature circles, project-based learning, peer review groups, lab groups, etc.
- ✓ To organize posts within your main group. For example, you can use the small groups feature for each unit of study, project, module, or discussion thread. Add all of your students to the 'small group' so that they can communicate about the unit/topic, etc. in an organized manner.

## Setting Up Small Groups:

1. On the left-hand pane, find 'Small Groups' and click the '+'.  
2. Select a name for the group.

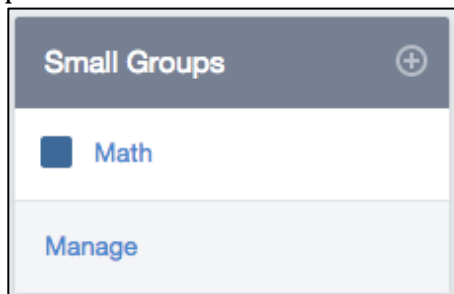


3. To add students, click the name of the small group within the left-hand pane.

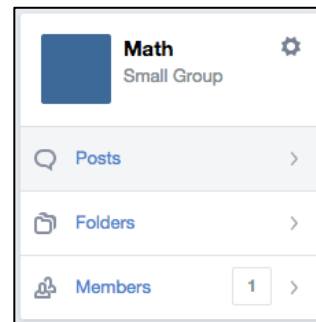


You should now see the new small group appear under the 'Small Groups' section within the left-hand pane.

4. In the left-hand pane, you should now see a section called 'Members'



5. Click 'Add Members'. You can either add certain students or all students from the main group.



6. At any time, you can remove or add members to a group. Simply click on 'Members' (see step 4) and this will bring up a list of all students within the group. You can remove using the 'Remove' button.
